Introduction

The State Resource Centre for Non-formal Education was inaugurated in the Indian Institute of Education in November 1976, at the hands of the Vice-President of India. It began to function fully from February 1977 when it received its first grant-in-aid from the Ministry of Education, Government of India. Initially, the Centre undertook activities for evolving the concept of non-formal education and acquainting the official and non-official educational workers in the State with the concept and possible programmes of non-formal education for the masses.

In March 1977, the Centre organised a National Seminar on the Concept of Non-formal Education. Leading national figures in the field of education participated in it and among those who contributed substantially to the development of the concept, were Shri J. P. Naik, then Member-Secretary of the ICSSR, Mr. Asher Deleon from UNESCO, Shri Rais Ahmed who was then Director of the NCERT and Smt. Padma Ramachandran, Jt. Secretary of the Union Ministry of Education. Subsequent to this national seminar, the SRC organised regional and district seminars on non-formal education. Stress was laid on formulation of experimental projects of non-formal education for the universalization of primary education in the age-group 6-14, and also to cover the age-group 15-24 and above, with the aim of giving the country's youth at least the basic minimum education essential for participating in the socio-economic transformation of Indian Society.

These initial activities of the SRC underwent a substantial change in 1978 when it was entrusted by the Government of India with duties in relation to the National Adult Education Programme. It had to undertake activities for promoting adult education mainly through the training of functionaries, preparation of experimental teaching-learning materials and through the training process, build up capabilities of officials and non-officials for systematically carrying on the tasks of the N.A.E.P.]

This Annual Report gives the summary of the activities of the State Resource Centre, Maharashtra for the year 1981-82.

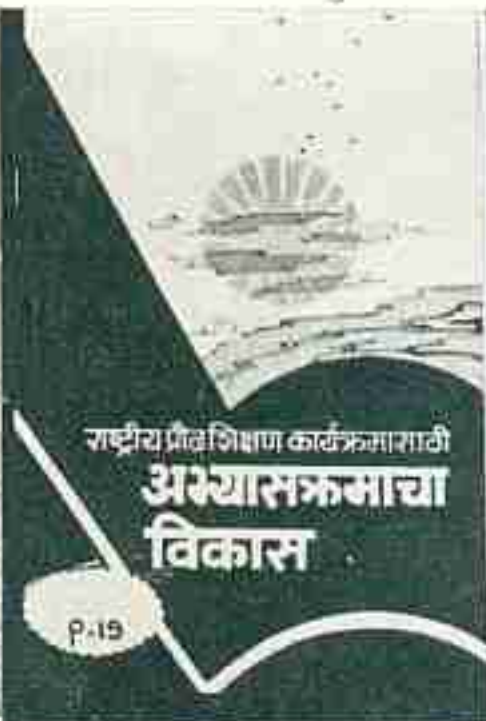
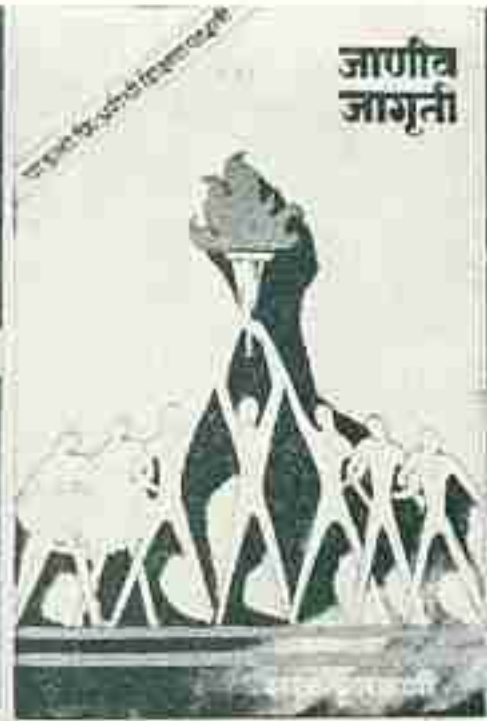
